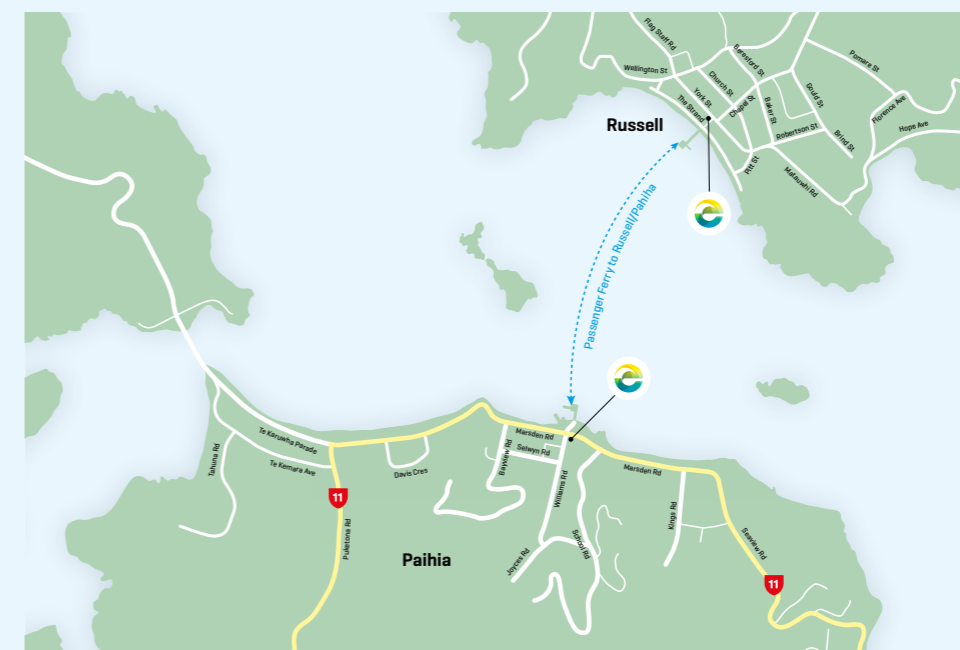
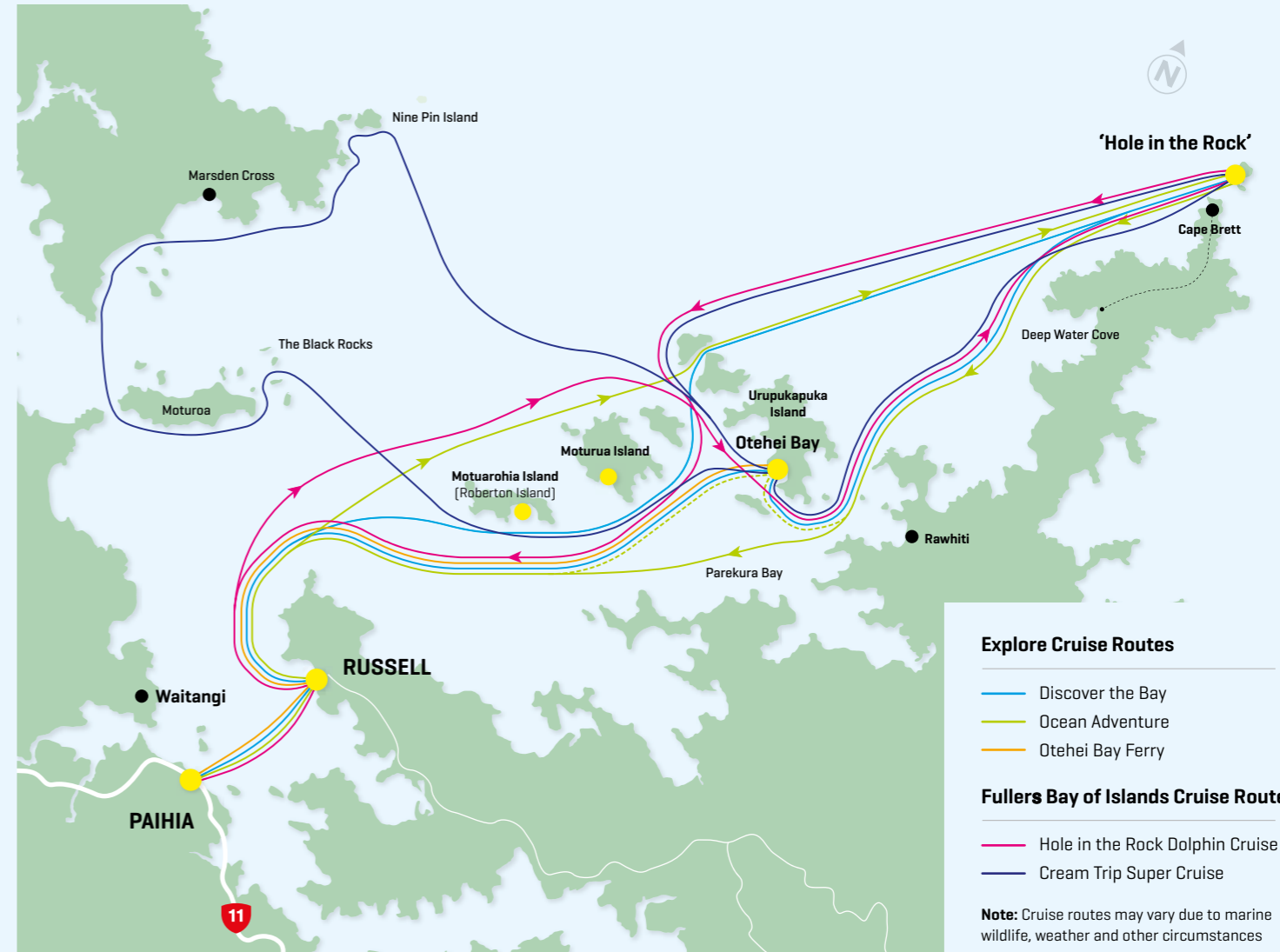
## Paua Cat

**Experience the stunning natural beauty of Northland with us. We offer options to view the awe-inspiring Hole in the Rock on Motukōkako, see marine mammals in their natural habitat and journey north to Cape Reinga and Ninety Mile Beach...**

When Albert Ernest Fuller began delivering coal around the Bay of Islands in 1887, he had no idea he was planting the seeds of a flourishing tourism industry. In the late 1920s he began transporting cream and delivering mail around the islands. Locals and visitors started tagging along for the ride, and word began to spread of the idyllic 'Cream Trip'. By the 1960s the Cream Trip was a well-known attraction, with tourists flocking to spend the day on the iconic Bay Belle launch.

Fullers Bay of Islands are part of the fabric in the region, and Explore Group is proud to carry on A.E. Fuller's tradition and be part of the history of the Bay of Islands.
